School Holiday Support

While school holidays are an exciting time for many families, they can present additional challenges for households already managing tight budgets. When schools close, families lose access to free school meals that many children rely on during term time. Parents also face increased childcare costs, adding pressure to household finances.

To help address these challenges, we provide food parcels throughout the holidays to families who need extra support. Working closely with



local schools and family support services, we encourage referrals for families who would benefit from this assistance. Our fortnightly food parcels contain enough nutritious food for the family for



at least three days, along with essential toiletries and household items.

This support is designed to help ease financial pressure during school breaks. By providing these practical resources, we aim to help bridge the gap between term-time support and holiday periods, making the school holidays a more manageable and enjoyable time.

ASDA Food Drive Success

Customers generously supported our ASDA food drive in June, donating food and essentials to help ensure we have the stock to provide food parcels to those in need in our community. Throughout the day, volunteers were stationed at the front of the store, greeting shoppers and providing shopping lists of our most needed items.

Some of these volunteers were students from Tadley Court School (a local school which provides specialist education for learners with learning difficulties). The students were an enthusiastic help in handing out shopping lists and packing up the donations we received. We were delighted to work with them to both support our food drive, and give students an opportunity to experience community volunteering and their involvement was much



appreciated! They even organised a collection with the rest of the school after the food drive!

ASDA customers donated a total of 48 crates of food and essential items, which weighed 447kg! This is approximately 1063 meals for those in need in our local community!



We also extend our heartfelt thanks to Carole, ASDA's Community Champion, who worked tirelessly to make this food drive possible. Her ongoing support and partnership enabled the food drive to take place and the foodbank to receive much need donations.
